Iris 360 FAQs

Can it record and store footage?

Yes, it can, it works similar to a DVR and stores the footage for a certain amount of time. The max storage is 512gb SD card.

Can it alert me to people in range of my vehicle?

Yes, it can, only if you purchase the Add-on microwave sensors and master controller, this will also need to be configured and calibrated in the IRIS 360 settings.

Will it work on plant vehicles?

yes, as long as they aren't rated over 32V as this is the max capacity for the unit. They are designed to fit to a multitude of vehicles including plant, HGV, LGV and cars.

Does it come with everything included?

No, you will need to buy a monitor and SD card. Please speak to a sales representative and they can quote you on a kit.

How do I calibrate the cameras?

The kit has calibration mats included, it also has an auto calibration feature but we would recommend following the user guide included in the kit to in order to calibrate it to utilise its full potential. It also has a user programmable interface to allow for non-symmetrical vehicles (such as plant machinery) to be configured on site via a laptop.

Are the cameras waterproof?

The cameras are IP69K rated, IP69K means a product is completely dustproof and can withstand washdown at pressures of 80 to 100 bar/1,160 to 1,450 PSI, in phases of 14 to 16 l/min, and at temperatures up to 176°F/80°C.
