# Titan 1ch & 2ch

## How long does it store videos for?

This is all dependant on the SD card size, the larger the capacity the more it will hold.

If you have a 2ch it will half the storage time as it is storing double the capacity of a 1ch.

We would recommend a 128gb SD card as this is the maximum the camera is compatible with.

### What is loop recording?

Loop recording is multiple small videos rather than one large file, the reason why we do this is for a multitude of reasons, main reason being that it is easier to download a 1-minute video than a one hour long video. Another reason why we do this is because of auto formatting, the camera needs to have storage to continue recording, so it will delete the oldest videos first to make way for new videos.

# Is it easy to install?

We recommend having a qualified auto electrician fit the camera as it can require soldering to the vehicle.

### Will soldering void my warranty?

This is dependent on the manufacturer of the vehicle, please contact them for further information.

If it does void warranty, your auto electrician creates a wiring loom fairly easy to make it plug and play.

## How do I recover footage?

You will need to buy an SD card with the camera, once it has been plugged in and recordings made you can take the card out and use an adapter to plug into a PC, the files will also have the Titan software on it that you can download and view from there.
